Guidance

Panel Meeting

On 21 March 2013 the Cambridgeshire Police and Crime Panel reviewed the draft Police and Crime Plan 2013-16.

Decision

In accordance with the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 and following consideration of the information submitted to it, the Panel endorsed the draft Police and Crime Plan 2013-16 as proposed by the Commissioner.

Reasons for the decision

The Panel considered that the draft Plan was acceptable and necessary for the continued provision of policing across the area covered by Cambridgeshire Constabulary.

The Panel made a range of suggestions for consideration by the Commissioner for future Plans including the desire to keep the Plan under review to ensure appropriate updates could be incorporated and requested that a report be submitted to a future meeting of the Panel to this effect.

Terms of Reference

The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 requires the Police and Crime Panel to review the draft Police and Crime Plan and make a report to the Commissioner on the proposed precept.
