The Panel considered that the draft variation to the Plan was acceptable and necessary for the continued provision of policing across the area covered by Cambridgeshire Constabulary.

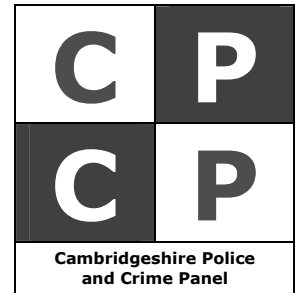
Terms of Reference
