Guidance

This report provides the recommendation made by the Cambridgeshire Police and Crime Panel Complaints Sub Committee. Its purpose is to outline the Sub Committees recommendation following its consideration of the two complaints outlined in the report submitted to the Sub Committee on 1 July 2016

Complaints Sub Committee Panel Meeting

On 11 July 2016, the Cambridgeshire Police and Crime Panel Complaints Sub Committee met to consider two complaints received against the Cambridgeshire Police and Crime Commissioner. The remit of the Sub Committee was to decide whether the complaints should be referred to the Independent Police Complaints Commission under Regulation 13 of the Elected Local Policing Bodies (Complaints and Misconduct) Regulations 2012 if they were considered to be serious or whether they could be considered by the Sub Committee under Regulation 15 or 28 of the Elected Local Policing Bodies (Complaints and Misconduct) Regulations 2012.

Decision

In accordance with the Elected Local Policing Bodies (Complaints and Misconduct) Regulations 2012 and following consideration of the complaints, the Sub Committee AGREED to refer the two complaints to the Independent Police Complaints Commission.

Reasons for the decision

The Sub Committee considered the two complaints and determined in line with Regulation 13 of the Elected Local Policing Bodies (Complaints and Misconduct) Regulations 2012 that they should be referred to the Independent Police Complaints Commission as serious complaints.
