

## **DECISION NOTICE - LICENSING ACT 2003 SUB-COMMITTEE**

## <u>APPLICATION OF THE PREMISES LICENCE - CO-OP, EAGLE WAY, HAMPTON VALE</u> PETERBOROUGH, PE7 8GS

## **8 DECEMBER 2017**

This Decision Notice refers to the application of the premises licence Co-Op, Eagle Way, Hampton Vale Peterborough, PE7 8GS.

The Sub-Committee considered the representations made today and in writing in relation to the application:

- From the Applicant's representative Richard Arnott; and
- Two residents who did not attend.

The Sub-Committee considered the information put before it and took into account the following facts:

- The local resident believes that granting an alcohol licence in the residential area which contains an extra care unit will have a detrimental effect on the local residents;
- The local resident believes that the premises would lead to street drinking in the area and associated anti-social behaviour;
- If a licence is granted there would be an increase in alcohol related incidents
- An increase in littering in the vicinity of the premises; and
- Increased traffic in the area with an increase vehicular noise and of car headlights shining in residents properties.

The Sub-Committee were reminded of the provisions within the Government guidance when considering granting a licence where representations have been received.

The Sub-Committee had not been presented with any information which causes concern. The Committee noted that there were no other representations from any other responsible authority.

The Sub-Committee therefore granted the licence as applied, for the licence for the premises, known as Co-Op, Eagle Way, Hampton Vale Peterborough, PE7 8GS.

Any party in objection to the decision may appeal to the Peterborough Magistrates Court within 21 days of receiving this formal notice at:
