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NOTICE OF PROPOSALS THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH MOVING TRAFFIC AMENDMENTS TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2014

Notice is hereby given that The Council of the City of Peterborough proposes to make the above mentioned Order under Section 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of this Order is to:

1. Introduce a 20mph speed limit on Russell Hill, Thornthugh from a point 342m west of its junction with Meadow Lane to its junction with the A1 and on the full lengths of Meadow Lane and Old Rectory Drive
2. Introduce a 20mph speed limit in a westerly direction on Nene Way, Sutton from a point 90m south of its junction with Peterborough Road, in a southerly direction on the Drift from a point 77m north of its junction with Nene Way, and on the full lengths of Manor Road, Graeme Road and Lovers Lane.
3. Introduce a 20mph speed limit on Katharine Way, Bretton in a northerly direction from a point 30m north of its junction with Bretton Way and on the full lengths of King Henry Chase, Strawberry Avenue and Munjac Close.
4. Introduce a 40mph speed limit on Deeping St James Road (B1162) from a point 120m south of its junction with Sutton's Lane to a point 32m south of its junction with Rippens Drive.
5. Introduce a 30mph speed limit on the full length of Franklins Way, Carr Road.
6. Introduce a 30mph speed limit on the Unnamed Road Leading to Tanholt Farm from its junction with Eyebury Road.
7. Amend Schedule 2 of The Council of the City of Peterborough (London Road, Hempested) (Bus Priority route) Traffic Regulation Order 2009 as follows. Column 5 items 1. and 2. The Type of Permitted Vehicle shall be Bus, Public Service Vehicle, and Motorcycle
8. Introduce a 7.5T weight restriction on London Road, Hempested between its junctions with Club Way and a point 10m north of its junction with St Margarets Road, including all existing and future side roads connecting to the restricted section above.
9. Revoke the part of the 7.5T weight restriction on Welland Road that lies between a point 315m east of its junction with Furze Ride and its junction with the A47 as made under The Council of the City of Peterborough (Welland Road Weight Limit Order) 2010.
10. Prohibit traffic flow in a westerly direction along Bamber Street between its junctions with Cromwell Road and Gladstone Street.
11. Revoke the prohibition of traffic on Dogsthorpe Road from turning left or right into Green Lane.
12. Prohibit traffic flow in a westerly direction along The Green, Werrington between its junction with Church Street and Hall Lane.
13. Prohibit traffic from undertaking the following manoeuvres at the new traffic signals at the junction of Station Road and Bourges Boulevard:
 - a) The right turn from Bourges Boulevard into Station Road
 - b) The U-turn from northbound to southbound on Bourges Boulevard
 - c) The U-turn from southbound to northbound on Bourges Boulevard
14. Revoke the 40mph speed limit on Bourges Boulevard that lies between a point 10m west of its junction with Wentworth Street and a point 160m north of its junction with Bright Street as made under The City of Peterborough (Part Bourges Boulevard) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 1980 such that the speed limit reverts to 30mph.
15. Introduce a 30mph speed limit on Sutton's Lane between a point 215m east of its junction with Lincoln Road and a point 330m west of its junction with Deeping St James Road.

The detailed plans indicating the lengths of road subject to the above amendments, may be seen together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, can be seen at the Town Hall Reception, Bridge Street, Central Library, Broadway and Bayard Place, Northminster Road, Peterborough, during normal office hours.

If you have any objections to the proposed Order they must be submitted in writing to the undersigned by the 12th January 2015 clearly stating your reasons for objecting to the proposals.

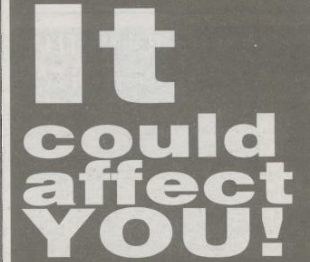
