Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

Licensees should note that the under enclosed Mandatory conditions should be read in conjunction with the granted licence and these conditions shall be enforceable where relevant to the operation of the premise and its activities.

Exhibition of films

This registration authorises the exhibition of films subject to the following conditions:

1. I will not exhibit any film unless –
 - (a) it has received a "U", "PG", "12", "12A", "15" or "18" certificate from the British Board of Film Classification; or
 - (b) it is a current newsreel which has not been submitted to the British Board of Film Classification.
2. Where films are classified by the film classification body, (British Board of Film Classification) I will make sure that children (persons under 18) are only admitted in accordance with the classification of the film:

U – Universal – suitable for audiences aged 4 years and over;
PG – Parental Guidance – some scenes may be unsuitable for young children;
12 – viewing by persons aged 12 years and over;
12A – viewing by persons aged 12 years or older or persons younger than 12 when accompanied by an adult;
15 – viewing by persons aged 15 years and over;
18 – viewing by persons aged 18 years and over.
3. Where the Licensing Authority has made a recommendation on the restriction of admission of children to a film, I will make sure that notices are displayed both inside and outside the premises so that persons are aware of the classification.

Supply of alcohol (Premises Licence)

This registration authorises the supply of alcohol subject to the following conditions:

4. No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when
 - (a) there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
5. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Door Supervision (where supervisors are engaged this condition applies)

6. All door supervisors will be Security Industry Authority registered.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

Crime and Disorder

7. Alcohol will only be supplied off the premises with a take-away meal or if the patron has previously had a meal at the restaurant in a container that is sealed
8. Food Deliveries: If an employee has reason to suspect that the person accepting a meal that contains alcohol is under the age of 21 then photographic ID will be requested.
9. Video/CCTV equipment shall be installed inside/outside the premises and maintained in working order.
10. Video/CCTV equipment will be set to record all licensed areas from the time that the premises open to the public until the premises closes and all members of the public have left.
11. Digital images shall be retained for at least one month and shall be produced to an authorised officer on demand.
12. Notices advising that CCTV has been installed on the premises shall be posted up so that they are clearly visible to the public within the licensed premises.
13. An authorised person will be available at all times on the premises to show CCTV images immediately or to an authorised officer on demand.
14. CCTV images will be clear and comprehensible.
15. Any new/existing CCTV system in place will be cleared for use by the Police/Licensing Authority.
16. Facilities will be in place for the immediate copying of CCTV images to a recognised media. These copied images will be made immediately available to an authorised officer on request.
17. Two SIA registered doors staff will be employed at the premises on Fridays and Saturdays (Saturday will include Sunday morning) from 02.00 to the time that all members of the public have left and the restaurant is closed for business. Door Staff will start at 00.00 if requested by the Police.

Public Safety

18. The premises will comply with the appropriate Fire, Health & Safety regulations

Public Nuisance

19. Music will be kept to an incidental background level.
20. Waste will be collected and deliveries will be made during reasonable hours.

21. The premises license holder shall take all necessary steps to ensure that noise or vibration is not noticeable at the façade of any noise sensitive premises / nearest residential property.
22. The placing of bottles into receptacles outside the premises shall take place at times that will minimise disturbance to nearby properties.
23. The premises licence holder shall implement a system to ensure that offensive smells from the licensed premises are not permitted so as to cause a nuisance to nearby properties and the premises are properly vented.

Protection of Children from Harm

24. Children under the age of 16 will not be allowed on the premises unless accompanied by a responsible adult (over 18). Anyone suspected of being under 18 will be asked to provide photo identification before being supplied alcohol.
25. Staff will be trained in appropriate ID procedures
26. The 'Challenge 21' initiative to prevent sales of alcohol to persons under 18 years of age will be implemented at the premises.
