

Motion from Councillor Sandford

"Council agrees to delete the changes to the constitution made by the Monitoring Officer as a result of the motion brought by Cllr Fitzgerald, as set out below, returning Standing Order 19 on Motions to its original form by removing the amendments made after the March meeting, and, in doing so, Council requests that the issue of how motions are handled and submitted to Council is dealt with at the next meeting of Constitution and Ethics Committee with a report back to this Council at its July meeting. Further I would ask Constitution and Ethics Committee to consider the business for the Annual Meeting with a view to including the 'Constitution' as an item.

The specific deletions to give effect to this motion are as follows:

- Delete the whole of paragraph 19.1 Drafting motions as set out in Part 4 Section 1 of the Council's Standing Orders
- Delete the whole of paragraph 19.2 Draft motions with major implications in the said Standing Orders
- Delete the whole of paragraph 19.3 Notice of draft motions with major implications in the said Standing Orders
- Amend the title and number of paragraph 19.4 to '19.1 Motions on Notice' and delete the words 'and motions with major implications' in that paragraph of the said Standing Orders, and
- Amend the numbers of the following paragraphs from 19.5 to 19.2 and 19.6 to 19.3 of the said Standing Orders."
