This Committee will be looking at how Peterborough can best support vulnerable adults and children now and in the future in light of both the current economic climate and finite resources.



From the A1(M)

Leave the A1(M) at junction 17, keeping to the right

hand lane on exit.

Join the A1139 (Fletton Parkway).

Continue along the A1139 (Fletton Parkway) and then Frank Perkins Parkway until junction 5.

At the roundabout at the bottom of the slip road, take the first exit onto Boongate (following signs for the Adult College).

At the next roundabout take the third exit onto Crawthorne Road.

Turn left into the College car park (see inset map).

Peterborough is on the main East Coast line and receives services from London King's Cross, Grantham, Leeds, Edinburgh, Newcastle, Leicester, Cambridge and Norwich. The station is 3/4 mile from the college.

Car Parking Pree car parking is available at the rear of the College and access from Crawthorne Road.
