Guidance

This report provides the recommendation(s) made by the Cambridgeshire Police and Crime Panel in accordance with Section 28(3), Part 4 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011. Its purpose is to outline the Panel's recommendations following its review of a draft variation to the Police and Crime Plan 2013-16.

Panel Meeting

On 5 November 2014 the Cambridgeshire Police and Crime Panel reviewed a draft variation to the Police and Crime Plan 2013-16.

Decision

In accordance with the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 and following consideration of the information submitted to it. Having reviewed the draft variation to the Police and Crime Plan the Panel AGREED to ENDORSE the variation to Objective 1 (Maintain Local Police Performance) of the Police and Crime Commissioner's Police and Crime Plan. The variation sought to update the Plan to reflect delivery of the Objective.
