6. Appointments to Committees and Other Authorities

A vote was taken and the Council **RESOLVED** (unanimous with no Members indicating to vote against or abstain) to:

- 2. Appoint the Chair and Vice-Chair of each of the Council's committees (Appendix 1 to the report).
- 3. Confirm the non-elected members of committees, as described at paragraph 2.3 of the report.
- 4. Make the following appointments or nominations for the 2023/2024 municipal year:

- a) Appoint the Leader of the Council to act as the Council's appointee to the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority and one substitute member (Appendix 4 to the report).
- b) Nominate two members to the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority Overview and Scrutiny Committee, and two substitute members from the same political parties as those nominated (Appendix 4 to the report).
- c) Nominate one member Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority Audit and Governance Committee and one substitute member from the same political party (Appendix 4 to the report).
- d) Appoint three members to the Police and Crime Panel and three substitute members from the same political parties as those appointed (Appendix 4 to the report).
- e) Appoint four members to the Fire Authority and four substitute members from the same political parties as those appointed (Appendix 4 to the report).
- 5. Appoint to the position of Armed Forces Champion, as set out in Appendix 4 to the report.
- Authorise the Monitoring Officer as Proper Officer, in respect of any other appointments to be made, to carry out the wishes of the Leaders of Political Groups in allocating Members to committees or other authorities, and to appoint those Members with effect from the date at which the Proper Officer is advised of the names of such Members.

8. Acquisition of Sand Martin House

- 1. Approve an increase of the Capital Programme to cover the cost of acquiring the freehold interest of Sand Martin House which is currently leased.
- 2. Approve the resulting budget virement between Corporate Property (rental cost) and Capital Financing (borrowing cost).
- 3. Delegate authority to the Executive Director of Corporate Services and Director of Law and Governance, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Finance and Corporate Governance to take all necessary steps including agreeing final terms and entering into all necessary agreements to facilitate the decision in Recommendation 1.
