

DECISION NOTICE

LICENSING ACT 2003 SUB-COMMITTEE

29 MAY 2012

APPEAL HEARING AGAINST EXPEDITED REVIEW

COCO, 11-13 BROADWAY, PETERBOROUGH, PE1 1SQ

We have considered the representations made on behalf of the premises licence holder, submitted today and those in writing.

We have considered the comments made by Cambridgeshire Constabulary (the responsible authority and applicants for the review).

In our deliberations we considered the various options available, being:

- whether the interim steps are necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives;
- should the steps be withdrawn or modified.

The decision of this Licensing Act 2003 sub committee is therefore to remove the suspension of the licence but to apply the following conditions with immediate effect:

- Ensure that the CCTV facility at the premises is to a standard acceptable by the Police and Licensing Authority;
- The licence holder or the Designated Premises Supervisor must be on the premises at all times during the sale of alcohol;
- The sale of alcohol to cease at 0.00am (midnight);
- The premises to close at 00.30 am;
- The emergency service be contacted immediately if an incident occurs that is considered to be serious; and
- The licence holder and DPS work more closely with the Police and Licensing Authority to promote the Licensing objectives and ensure the conditions of the licence are upheld.
