- 9. Members to debate application and seek advice from Officers where appropriate.
- 10. Members to reach decision.

The total time for speeches from Ward Councillors, Parish Council, Town Council or Neighbourhood representatives shall not exceed <u>ten minutes</u> or such period as the Chairman may allow with the consent of the Committee.

The total time for speeches in respect of each of the following groups of speakers shall not exceed <u>five minutes</u> or such period as the Chairman may allow with the consent of the Committee.

Section 3 Planning Policy

National Planning Policy Framework (2012)

Paragraph 19 – Building a strong, competitive economy

Planning should operate to encourage and not impede sustainable growth. Significant weight should be placed on the need to support economic growth through the planning system.

Section 7 Recommendation

Amendment to Condition C2 to read:

C 2 No taxis or private hire vehicles shall visit or operate from the site, other than a frequency of once per week in which to drop off any takings and not outside the hours of 0800 to 1800.

Reason: In order to prevent undue noise and disturbance and to preserve the amenities of neighbouring residents in accordance with Policy CS16 of the Peterborough Core Strategy DPD (2011).

Addition of Condition C6:

C6 Notwithstanding the details hereby approved, no more than six full time employees (or equivalent part-time employees) shall work from the site.

Reason: To ensure sufficient car parking is provided on site and prevent any undue pressure for on-road parking in accordance with Policy CS14 of the Peterborough Core Strategy DPD (2011).

Revision to condition 7 as follows:

C 7 Prior to the commencement of development a scheme for the hard and soft landscaping of the site shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The scheme shall be carried out as approved no later than the first planting season following the occupation of any building or the completion of development, whichever is the earlier.

The scheme shall include the following details:

- Proposed finished ground and building slab levels
- Planting plans for replacement trees, species, numbers, size and density of planting

• A Management Regime for the existing and proposed landscaping of the site

• Details of the boundary treatments

Reason: In the interests of the visual appearance of the development and the enhancement of biodiversity in accordance with policies CS16 and CS21 of the Adopted Peterborough Core Strategy DPD and policies LNE9 and LNE10 of the Peterborough Local Plan (First Replacement) 2005.
