Notice is hereby given that The Council of the City of Peterborough made the above mentioned Order under Section 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

# The effect of this Order is to:

a) reduce the speed limit from the national speed limit to 30mph along the length of West Street (B1443) from Helpston for a distance of 215m north of its junction

- Langley Bush Road b) reduce the speed limit from the national speed limit to 30mph along Langley Bush Road from Helpston for a distance of 195m south of its junction with West Street
- Soling Failong Langley Bush Road from Helpston for a distance of 195m south of its junction with West Street (B1443)
  c) reduce the speed limit from the national speed limit to 30mph along the length of Glinton Road (B1443) from Helpston for a distance of 240m east of its junction with the main rail line level crossing.
  d) reduce the speed limit from the national speed limit to 30mph along Church Street, from Northborough for a distance of 125m east of its junction with Pasture Lane.
