Early Years Programme.

A programme of structured play-based sessions, using the principles of the Early Years Foundation Stage, to support children's early learning and development. These sessions will be delivered by highly qualified early year's practitioners who have strong, sound knowledge of child development. They will focus on providing activities that are particularly crucial for supporting young children's curiosity and enthusiasm for learning, as well as building their capacity to learn.

The early year's practitioner will use their knowledge and understanding of the differing ways young children learn to ensure well balanced and planned sessions. In their role they will also model good practice in supporting young children, as they learn with and through other people, especially their parents/carers and other children. The practitioner will ensure that sessions are planned, taking into consideration thoughts and ideas of parents, alongside the interests of the child/children.

These sessions will not only provide children with exciting stimulating opportunities to explore and learn but also offer parents ideas and suggestions as to how best continue supporting their child's learning and development at home.
