## Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

Licensees should note that the under enclosed Mandatory conditions should be read in conjunction with the granted licence and these conditions shall be enforceable where relevant to the operation of the premise and its activities.

### Supply of alcohol (Premises Licence)

This registration authorises the supply of alcohol subject to the following conditions:

1. No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when
  - (a) there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - (b) when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

An irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children
4. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
  - (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

**Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule****Crime & Disorder**

5.	Video/CCTV equipment shall be installed inside/outside the premises and maintained in working order.
6.	Video/CCTV equipment will be set to record all licensed areas from the time that the premises open to the public until the premises close and all members of the public have left.
7.	Images shall be retained for at least ten days and shall be produced to an authorised officer on demand.
8.	An authorised person will be available at all times on the premises to show CCTV images immediately or to an authorised officer on demand.
9.	CCTV images will be clear and comprehensible.
10.	Any person working at the premises must be able to verbally challenge any customer purchasing alcohol.
11.	A bespoke training package for all members off staff at the premises should be purchased from a reputable training company/consultancy. This package should be developed specifically to ensure that all staff are trained correctly in preventing underage sales of alcohol. All staff training records should be made available to any member of police staff (including PCSO's) or any authorised Peterborough City Council Officer.
12.	No alcohol is to be purchased by leaseholders or their managers & staff from \ vendors who call at the premises
13.	Invoices (originals or copies) relating to the purchased stocks must be kept at the premises and made available on request of any responsible authority or HMRC
14.	The premises must maintain an ultra-violet light and if any spirits are identified as non-fluorescent or are otherwise suspicious the premises licence holder or their manager or staff must inform the local Trading Standards department and HMRC as soon as possible.
15.	The premises will adopt the age verification policy of 'Challenge 25'. Signage detailing this policy will be placed in prominent positions within the premises.

**Public Safety**

16.	A fire risk assessment required under the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 (as amended) will be completed and be available for inspection by an authorised officer.
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**Protection of Children from Harm**

17.	The 'Challenge 25' initiative to prevent sales of alcohol to persons under 18 years of age will be implemented at the premises.
18.	Signage will be prominently placed within the premises advertising the fact that the premises operates the 'Challenge 25' initiative.
19.	Any potential sale of alcohol that is refused will be logged in a refusal register and be available to an authorised officer on request.
