Appeal_Street Trading Consent

This is an appeal against the decision dated 29th June 2015 to refuse consent for street trading at the rear of 5 Field Walk, Peterborough PE1 5DP.

It is disputed that there have been sufficient and/or any noise complaints from householders in the near vicinity of the said premises, in support of which I seek to rely on the attached statement of support which has been signed by local residents.

It is further disputed that there have been sufficient and/or any parking issues in support of which I again seek to rely on the attached statement. Furthermore, there is a designated car park adjacent to the proposed site for which the consent was being sought and which has ample car parking space so I fail to understand how there could be any parking issues by the grant of this consent.

As for the obstruction to the highway. I understand this to relate to the parking issues which I deny but which the council claims may arise which in any event will stand and fall with the parking issue which itself has not been sufficiently established. Further and in the alternative, the intended trade will operate from the rear of the said property and away/off the highway.

In the second part of the second paragraph it is claimed by the council that **(emphasis added)** *'...consent to trade in this location may lead to disruption for local residents and continued, or an increase in road safety issues.'*

This would in the first instance appear to be sheer speculation. Furthermore I fail to understand the basis of this claim made by the council when the local residents are very supportive of my intended business. I have attached letters from the local residents who have invited and encouraged me to trade in the area. The letters are self explanatory and should alleviate this ill founded assumption made by the council. Furthermore, the business is intended to operate off the road and as mentioned in the initial application it is from the rear of a house so will not cause any disruption at all to the residents and/or any continued or increase in road safety issues.

The Licensing Department of Peterborough City Council have failed to substantiate any of the reasons it has given for refusing to grant me consent for street trading.

It is questionable how the Licensing Department has arrived at the decision dated 29th June 2015 in light of the evidence submitted herewith. If, as claimed any information has been received by the Licensing Department it is unclear what verifications the said department has undertaken to establish the proximity of the alleged informants to the area in question i.e. 5 Field Walk. It ought to be necessary for the Licensing Department to scrutinise any information it claims to have received as otherwise someone in Australia can allege that there is noise pollution in Field Walk and, as in the present circumstances, override the wishes of the local residents.

I have pursued all appropriate avenues to seek permission to trade and have also provided evidence to support my claim and rebut the unsubstantiated claims made by the Licensing Department of Peterborough City Council.

I feel it is grossly unfair to deny me consent for trading as I am a single mother simply trying to earn a respectable living, not wishing to rely on public funds. I requested permission to trade in the area on Wellington Street allotted to a car boot sale but was told by the responsible person, 'Tony' that there was already a business selling fruit and vegetable in the car boot and therefore I was not given permission. It was for this reason that I started to trade, within my legal rights, at 5 Field Walk but unfortunately as a result and despite me having made an application for the requisite consent at the Licensing Department, I was harassed and insulted by local wardens against whom I have lodged a complaint and awaiting a response (copy of complaint attached). I fail to understand how and why an already established business with retail outlets in Peterborough is given permission to trade at the car boot whereas someone like myself is not granted that permission. Surely this cannot be the essence or spirit of the car boot sale.

For the aforementioned reasons I request that my appeal be allowed and that I be granted the appropriate consent.

Re: Trading - Garage Sale

With reference to your letter dated 29 June 2015 refusing permission for me to use my garage to sell bric-a-brac on Sundays. As advised in the letter I would like to appeal against your decisions on following grounds:

1. I strongly dispute the noise complaint as I only trade on Sundays whilst the Car- Boot sale is going on in the Wellington street car park, which is during the day, 10:00 to 14:00.
2. There are no car-parking issues as no one can park or is allowed to park, outside my garage, people who come to my garage are those who go the Car-boot-sale and park their vehicles there, so it does not obstruction of the highway.
3. I have spoken to my neighbours and they have assured me that they do not have any objection to my trading and I have enclosed letters from them stating their "no objections".
4. I support myself and my wife through this trading and as a part-time escort with a taxi company. I do not claim any benefits. This additional income stops me from becoming a Burdon on the local authority and the tax payer.
5. I am 58 years old and suffer from poor health, and this is the only type of work I can manage, otherwise I would have taken a stall on car boot sale. I am not able to carry heavy loads.

I would like to reiterate that I only open my garage during the hours when Sunday Car-Boot Sale is going on so as not to cause any problems either to the road users or my neighbours.

In view of above facts I would urge you to reconsider your original decision and kindly grant me the license to continue trading.

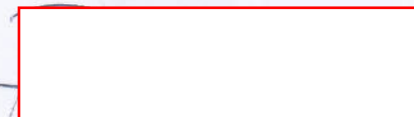


