

Inspector Maddox referred to previous incidents involving alcohol that had been stored at the back of the shop and priced when there was no licence in place for the sale of alcohol and an incident relating to counterfeit and duty free tobacco which was voluntarily surrendered to officers.

Mediation had since taken place and a number of suggested conditions had been agreed between the DPS and Cambridgeshire Constabulary. The DPS had also offered a one month suspension of the licence to allow for the conditions to be implemented.

The sub-committee retired to consider the application.

RESOLVED:

To revoke the premises licence.

Reasons for the Decision:

In view of the findings of fact and submissions made, and having regard to the comments made by the responsible authorities the sub-committee was satisfied on a balance of probability and considering all the circumstances that the decision to revoke the licence was proportionate and appropriate in view of the nature of the alleged offence.

In coming to its decision, the Sub Committee had regard to Peterborough City Council's Statement of Licensing Policy and the National Guidance.
