NEW GUIDANCE AND IMPACT

- Local Outbreak Plan, following discussion with SCG, Health protection board and Health and Wellbeing committee – public facing document published by government deadline on June 30th.
- Incident management team requirements around clusters communications support required at each specific work around Princes in Wisbech, HM Fresh in Hunts and The Beeches
- Further requirements around active travel proposals (90 cycle ways) and information around ETOs
- Further relaxation of lock down restrictions planning for communications around pubs and restaurant reopening on July 4th
- Planned changes to Shielded groups comms activities linked to the changed priorities of hubs
- Comms support for the publication of new guidance announced for school openings in Sept.
- Communications planning to support the announcement of Pillar 2 results being included in national figures which highlighted a rate of infection in Peterborough which is higher than the East of England average

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NEW CHALLENGES AND ACTIVITY

- Rapid recovery team comms activities linked to new information received about outbreaks linked to postcodes along Lincoln Road in Peterborough
- Physical activity campaigns linked to shielded groups or over 60s launched
- Planning for a wider campaign commissioned by SCG to break through 'fatigue' around government messaging
- Equalities work, linked to both increased risk factors from pandemic and BLM
- Vivacity contract issues media handling, staff and updates following PCC scrutiny

- Test and trace information to support continued relaxation of lockdown
- Comms support at the daily outbreak management meeting and at all IMTs
- Communication support linked to all the changes to services now being announced libraries, registrars, coroners changes to city centres (Peterborough)
