Hi,

Thank you for your email, I hope you can assist further.

If Cambridgeshire & Peterborough Safeguarding Partnership Boards (Children and Adults) is not the appropriate body, do you know who is?

The Licensing Act 2003 requires the Licensing Authority to determine who is the competent body to advise on such matters, as they are considered a Responsible Authority. Which means they are a consultee on applications, policies, etc. see relevant Section below.

Section 13(2)(f) reads

(f) a body which—

(i) represents those who, in relation to any such area, are responsible for, or interested in, matters relating to the protection of children from harm, and(ii) is recognised by the licensing authority for that area for the purposes of this section as being competent to advise it on such matters,

We are required by the legislation to 'nominate' the body and provide contact information within the policy. If this is not yourselves, then we need to establish who the correct body is, to ensure the prescribed application process is being correctly followed, and the policy is current.
