1. PURPOSE AND REASON FOR REPORT

1.1 The purpose of this report is to advise Council of changes made to the Executive Delegations by the Leader and for Council to note these changes.

2. CHANGES TO THE EXECUTIVE DELEGATIONS

2.1 At the meeting of Annual Council on 22 May 2023, the Leader of the Council notified Council of his scheme of delegations.

2.2 On the 7 June 2023 Councillor John Howard resigned from his position as ‘Cabinet Member for Adults Services and Public Health’.

2.3 The Leader has therefore made the following changes to his Cabinet appointments and scheme of delegations:

- The deletion of the position ‘Cabinet Member for Adults Services and Public Health’.
- The alteration of the position of ‘Leader of the Council’ to ‘Leader of the Council and Cabinet Member for Adults Services and Public Health’.
- The addition of the position ‘Cabinet Advisor for Public Health’, to be filled by Councillor David Over
- The addition of the position ‘Cabinet Advisor for Adults Services’, to be filled by Councillor Brian Tyler.

2.4 These changes have been agreed by the Leader via CMDN ‘Leader Appointment of Cabinet and Scheme of Cabinet Delegations 2023/24 – JUN23/CMDN/15’, effective from 5 July 2023.
