I am writing to object to the Tree Preservation Order (TPO) that has been served on the 13th June 2024 for the retention of a tree on my neighbour's property. The Tree Preservation Order number is 24/00005/TPO.

Thank you for consulting me about the order, however I support the view that the tree should be removed for various reasons. I have raised in the past my concerns with the lack of light that makes it's way to my house and the effect that the lack of light has on me. This tree contributes towards the lack of light all year round, and must contribute even more so for the residents of number 8. I do not feel comfortable being outside in the dark evenings due to the lack of light and the removal of this tree would only help that.
