On behalf of the Safer Communities Service, I write in support of the constabulary's application to request a review and revocation of the premises licence as a result of criminal activity relating to:

- Illegal tobacco products found on the premises and persons involved in the premises suspected of facilitating the sales of illicit goods.
- Possession and suspected illegal sales of a controlled substance

As well as a breach of condition 10 of the premises licence in relation to CCTV.

International Food Centre at Units 1 & 2, 41 Lincoln Road is situated in an area of the city which is subject to several measures aimed at tackling and reducing criminal and anti-social behaviour:

- The Millfield, New England, Eastfield & Embankment Public Spaces Protection Order,
- Cumulative Impact Policy
- the multi-agency Alliance/Clear, Hold, Build Home Office initiative aimed at ensuring a safer, better place for residents and businesses by tackling organised crime.

Any form of criminal activity cannot be condoned by responsible authorities. It is on this basis that the Safer Communities Service supports the Constabulary's application for a review of the premises licence for International Food Centre. This is in the interest of community safety due to the licensing objectives of 'the prevention of crime and disorder' and 'public safety' not being upheld.
