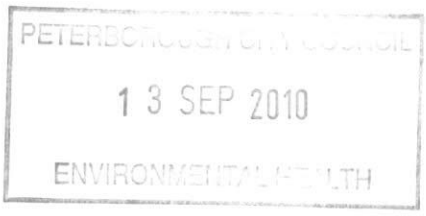

The premises has failed five (5) test purchasing operations listed below and during this time has retained the same premises licence holder

Although the failure dates cover a period spanning three (3) years, the number and continuing failures raise serious cause for concern.

The premises licence holder, Murco Petroleum Limited, have in place quite rigorous training procedures concerning the sale of alcohol to children, but it appears from the failures, that these are not being adhered to.

Both the police and the council have had meetings with representatives of the company but the problems continue to persist. A meeting with the company in 2007 resulted in a review application being withdrawn after certain assurances were given regarding preventing further underage sales and the removal of the DPS and a pledge to ensure staff are fully trained in preventing underage sales

A meeting was held with representatives of the premises licence holder after the failed test purchase on 12/3/10. This meeting, held on 16/4/10, resulted in a further pledge from the premises licence holders to put in place a bespoke training package at the premises and also to ensure that re-training is given to all staff members on a regular basis.

I do acknowledge that immediately after the failed test purchases in March & July 2010 the premises licence holder did voluntarily stop the sales of alcohol.

The issue of the safety of children must therefore be at the forefront of any action taken

Training procedures have been put in place but failed

DPS changes on a number of occasions which have failed to stop underage sales

Persistently selling alcohol to children
