300 kits have now been purchased



Youth Activities

The young people from the Youth Forum worked together to identify a long list of equipment which could be utilised for a 'Youth Café' in Hampton and Orton. The equipment is currently being purchased by PCC 8-19yrs Service.

The improvement works at Hinchcliffe have now been completed – see photos below.

Due to the collaboration between the Parks & Open Spaces and Highways Teams, there was a budget saving totalling £3,500 once all works were completed.
